Kids and Adults compete at Queensboro Arm Wrestling Championships Sept. 25 & 26

Floral Park, Queens, NY. Sept.13, 2010 -- The New York Arm Wrestling Association and Queens Farm Museum announced today that over 200 men, women and children would flex their muscles and come to grips at the TWO-DAY **CLEAR 4 G Wireless Internet Sponsored**, 33rd Annual Queensboro Arm Wrestling Championships to be held on Sat. Sept. 25, 2010 and Sun. Sept. 26, 2010 at 1 P.M. on the main stage at the **Queens County Fair** located at the **Queens County Farm Museum** 73-50 Little Neck Parkway Floral Park, NY 11004 – 718-347-327

Saturday, Sept. 25, 2010

The NYC Junior and Novice Arm Wrestling Championships will be staged on Saturday, Sept. 25, 2010 for boys and girls 7 to 17 years old and an event for Novice Adults (first time beginners - men and women) in various weight and age categories. First, second and third place awards are given and boys and Girls have an opportunity to compete just for the price of general admission, which is \$7 for adults and \$4 for children under 12. Novice 18+ entry is \$10. Parent or guardian signature is required for anyone under 17.

Sunday, Sept. 26, 2010

On Sunday, September 26, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. contestants will attempt to qualify for the year-end Empire State Arm Wrestling Finals There are 13 Amateur and Pro weight class categories and awards will be given to first, second and third place winners. **Ironmind.com-Captains of Crush Grippers (COC)** Queensboro Strongest man and women will receive the Queens COC MVP and \$100 cash prizes. Entry Fees are \$15 for amateurs and \$20 for pros and does not include general admission. Gene Camp said, "We are pleased that the Best Grippers in the world are sponsoring the MVP awards."

The 33rd Annual CLEAR Queensboro Armwrestling Championships are part of the New York 'Golden Arm' Series, which consists of up to six preliminary championships held in each of the five NYC Boroughs and Long Island and culminates into the Empire State finale. Due to budget crises this year the NYAWA could only produce two qualifying events which means the Empire State Finals could be an open walk-in competition. The Empire State Golden Arm Tournament of Champions will be held on November 18, 2010 at the Port Authority Bus Terminal's North Wing/Main Concourse at 625 8th Ave. in NYC.

Gene Camp, the founder and president of the 33-year old New York Arm Wrestling Association (NYAWA) said, "The CLEAR Queensboro Arm Wrestling Championships is the oldest of all the NYC Borough championships because the first official NYAWA event was held in Queens in 1977 at the old Sunnyside Gardens on Queens Blvd. in Sunnyside." Camp continued, "The Queens championship is also one of the most exciting events of the NY Golden Arm Series because Queens has the best ranked arm wrestlers of the entire city and challengers have come from far away as Russia, Turkey, Brazil and other foreign lands for the challenge. We are also excited about crowning the NYC Junior Arm Wrestling Champions, which is a certain audience crowd pleaser"
